Engineering Scholarship

Students eligible for any of the Presidential Scholarship awards and majoring in Engineering are also eligible for an Engineering Scholarship of \$1,000 a year, renewable for four years. Students must maintain a 3.0 to keep their scholarship.

Klamath County Scholarship

Students who qualify for a Presidential Scholarship AND graduated from a high school in Klamath County are eligible for a one-year non-renewable scholarship of \$1,000.

Other Eligibility Criteria*

Full-time, degree seeking first-year students only. Students must maintain full time status of 12 or more credits per term at a 3.0 GPA to renew up to four years.

Exclusions: OHSU Nursing, Medical Lab Science, Paramedic, and Post-baccalaureate students; students receiving reciprocity, attending the Boeing campus, online campus, or who are non-degree seeking students. Students in pre-Nursing, pre-Medical Lab Science, or pre-Paramedic are eligible until fully admitted into these programs. International students and students receiving Veterans benefits are not eligible.

*Other restrictions may apply. Contact the Admissions Office to verify eligibility.

Automatic, guaranteed consideration if admitted by **March 1**. Oregon Tech reserves the right to not consider any admitted students after the March 1 Priority Date. Must deposit by May 1 to reserve awards. Awards may vary depending on level of academic achievement, standing, major, and financial need.
