



## Medical Imaging Technology Program Selection Criteria

Selection will be based upon the following criteria:

### 1. GPA

A minimum weighted GPA of 2.95 is required to apply to one of the five MIT programs.

The following courses are weighted toward selection:

BIO 231	4 credits
BIO 232	4 credits
BIO 233	4 credits
BIO 200	2 credits
MIT 103	3 credits
CHEM 101	3 credits
CHEM 104	1 credit
MATH 112	4 credits
<b>Total</b>	<b>25 credits</b>

### How to calculate the Weighted GPA

Grade values:

A = 4

B = 3

C = 2

D = 0 (Not passing)

**Course Grade value x Credit = point value**

**Total Course point value/Total credits = Weighted GPA**

Example weighted GPA calculation:

Course	Course Credit	Grade	Credit Value	Point Value
BIO 231	4	B	4x3	12
BIO 232	4	A	4x4	16
BIO 233	4	A	4x4	16
BIO 200	2	B	2x3	6
MIT 103	3	A	3x4	12
CHEM 101	3	B	3x3	9
CHEM 104	1	A	1x4	4
MATH 112	4	B	4x3	12
<b>TOTAL</b>	<b>25</b>			<b>87</b>

**87 points/25 credits possible = 3.48 Weighted GPA**

These courses must also be **completed successfully** but are **not calculated** into the weighted GPA:

WRI 121	Writing	3 credits
PSY 201, 202, or 203	Psychology	3 credits
SPE 111	Public Speaking	3 credits

## 2. APPLICATION & INTERVIEW

Applicants are **required** to attend the Selection Interview Day to be considered for an MIT program. You must fill out the MIT Application/RSVP and submit **NO LATER** than the posted due date. You will receive immediate confirmation that your Application/RSVP has been processed.

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING APPLICATION AND TRANSCRIPTS!!!!

- **ADMISSION TO OIT:**

Students must be admitted to OIT prior to applying to an MIT program. OIT applications can be accessed online at the OIT website (<http://www.oit.edu>) in the upper right corner of the webpage, click the box "I am a ...." and choose the appropriate selection. You will then find the OIT application link.

- **APPLICATION TO THE MIT PROGRAM:**

Applications are available online at the MIT Selection website (<http://www.oit.edu/academics/health-arts-sciences/medical-imaging-technology>). Applications are submitted electronically.

- **BACKGROUND CHECKS:**

You do **NOT** need to complete this prior to selection. Students are required to complete a background check **UPON ACCEPTANCE INTO A PROGRAM.**

- **UNOFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS (On Campus and Transfer Students):**

These are your unofficial grades that you can print off the web. **ALL students MUST** bring their unofficial grades to the Selection Interview Day. Please e-mail [ronda.keating@oit.edu](mailto:ronda.keating@oit.edu) for additional information.

### TRANSFER STUDENTS ONLY!

- **OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS (Transfer Students only):**

These are transcripts your college will send to the OIT Registrar's office. These **MUST** be received by the time you apply to the MIT Program. You will also need to send updated Official Spring transcripts to the OIT Registrar's office by the due date specified in the application. If transcripts are not received, you will be ineligible for consideration to the MIT program.
