## Audit Grades OIT-14-021

A student has the option to enroll in a class for informational purposes only. This enrollment is classified as an audit and is regulated by the following procedures:

- 1. Audit classes are charged at regular tuition rates as printed in the class schedule.
- 2. The only grade an audit class may be granted is "N" (audit). The N grade is disregarded in the grade point average and is not valid toward graduation requirements.
- 3. Class attendance shall be in accordance with the instructor's attendance policy for all students in the class.
- 4. Instructors having audit students have no obligation to grade or record the audit student's work.
- 5. An audit option may be requested during the registration period. Changes "to" or "from" the audit option may be requested no later than the tenth academic day of the term.
- 6. Students auditing a course may, during a later term:
  - a. register the same course for credit,
  - b. challenge the course by examination.
