From tutoring to resume review, we've got you covered!










Advice from your Faculty!



- See your advisor earlier than fall term to map out courses for the entire academic year – sometimes on-campus vs online options change by term and I can help!
- I can help with Gen Ed course selections; for example, certain Psychology courses are more emphasized on MCAT for Pre-Meds.

- Connect with the IEEE club. It is active and has a lot of support for students
- Don't be afraid of the project lab; there
 is a paid student to help you get started
- Meet with your advisor; if your advisor is not responsive ask the department chair to change your advisor





- Find out who is your advisor is and set up a meeting as soon as possible.
- After your first lecture, introduce yourself to the instructor so they know you as a person and not just an ID number on a roster.
- Talk to the people in your class (engineers are notorious for being antisocial) – these are the people who will laugh with you, cry with you and keep you sane (hopefully) as you progress through your degree.


