Hi Erin,

I just wanted to share some quick points with the committee. I have attached the amount of maximum Pell grant would cover towards the estimated tuition per year and graph on sheet two.

In 2012-2013 the difference was \$2,204, in 2020-2021 this has increased to \$4,924, but Allied Health and Engineering students are looking at a difference of \$8,148.

Stafford loans have not increased since 2012 either, but I just wanted to share a some quick and easy data that shows financial aid is not keeping up with the tuition increases.
