Application Process	Online application only. Steps for dual enrollment: 1. Students must apply as a first year or transfer student with Oregon Tech (www.oit.edu/apply). 2. After the student is admitted, an email is sent from Oregon Tech with a link to the dual enrollment application. 3. Student must complete the dual enrollment application. 4. After the dual enrollment application is complete, Oregon Tech transmits the data to the community college.		
Re-enrolling Process	Students who have not attended OIT in 4 or more terms must fill out OIT's re-enrolling form (https://www.oit.edu/admissions/returning-student). Submit transcripts for other colleges attended after leaving OIT. Clackamas Community College transcripts will automatically be sent to OIT.		
Deadlines & App. Fee	Completed applications are due 3 weeks before the term starts. We require a \$50 application fee at the time the application is submitted unless the student has an application fee waiver. We also require a confirmation of attendance and \$100 enrollment deposit, which goes towards their tuition and fees when they take classes and is non-refundable after certain dates, depending on the term. Also, if a student applies to OIT and does not take classes in the term they are admitted, they must re-apply.
