Global and Cultural Awareness Requirement

Course Approval Form

In order for a course to receive a Global and Cultural Awareness (GCA) designation, it must be designed to help students demonstrate all eight of the outcomes listed below. The course may, of course, be designed to help students meet other learning outcomes as well.

- Demonstrate intercultural competence.
- Demonstrate the ability to engage in conversations about global/cultural differences appropriately and respectfully.
- Demonstrate the ability to communicate, interact, and work positively with individuals from various cultural, co-cultural, global groups or from different backgrounds.
- Describe forces that change and shape cultures.
- Demonstrate the ability to compare and contrast cultures.
- Demonstrate knowledge of how culturally-based assumptions influence perceptions, behaviors, and policies.
- Demonstrate understanding of relationships between groups as well as the development of varied views, cultural practices, and patterns.
- Recognize cultural biases as well as stereotyping, racism, prejudice, ethnocentrism, and discrimination.
