### Engineering Scholarship

Students eligible for any of the Presidential Scholarship awards and majoring in Engineering are also eligible for an Engineering Scholarship of \$1,000 a year, renewable for four years. Students must maintain a 3.0 to keep their scholarship.

### Other Eligibility Criteria\*

Full-time, degree seeking first-time Oregon Tech students with a Fall term start. Students must maintain full time status of 12 or more credits per term at a 3.0 to renew up to four years.

Exclusions: Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE), OHSU Nursing, Medical Lab Science, Paramedic, post-baccalaureate, students receiving reciprocity, attending the Boeing campus, online, and non-degree seeking students.

Students in pre-Nursing, pre-Medical Lab Science, or pre-Paramedic are eligible until fully admitted into these programs. International students are not eligible.

\*Other restrictions may apply. Contact the Admissions Office to verify eligibility.

### APPLY EARLY!

Automatically considered if admitted by **August 15 Priority Date**. Oregon Tech reserves the right to not consider any admitted students after the August 15 Priority Date. Awards may vary depending on level of academic achievement, standing, major, and financial need.
