





The steep changes related to the pandemic and the greater stability today are evident in the long-term trend




Enrollment has stabilized but not returned to prepandemic levels.

Full-time equivalent counts are defined in the colleges as the total number of clock hours in which all students enrolled divided by 510, and in the universities as credit hours divided by 15 at the undergraduate level, by 12 at the graduate level (excluding PhD) and by 9 at the PhD level


