OUTSTANDING STUDENT INVOLVEMENT AWARD PORTLAND-METRO 2024

The ***Outstanding Student Involvement Award*** is presented to a Portland Metro student each year who has helped to develop a sense of campus community and academic engagement among students, faculty, and staff during their entire experience at the Oregon Tech, Portland-Metro Campus.

SELECTION CRITERIA:

1. Enrolled as a degree-seeking during the current academic year (2023-2024)
2. Nominee should be outstanding in their involvement with fellow students, faculty, and staff
3. The nomination should provide a brief description of the student's involvement in each of these areas (during nominee's entire experience at the Portland-Metro campus):
 - a. 40% Student Involvement (i.e. engaged students in the campus community through their involvement in various campus activities, events and/or clubs)
 - b. 40% Academic involvement (i.e., engaged students in the academic learning environment)
 - c. 20% Collaborative spirit with students, faculty, and staff.
4. Student will complete the Student Biography form by April 17th, 2024 at Midnight
5. Review of Recommendation Letters and Student Biography form. *Incomplete or late student portfolios may not receive full consideration.

The **Outstanding Student Involvement Award** consists of an engraved permanent plaque housed on the Wilsonville campus. The recipient is given an engraved plaque and certificate to keep.

SUBMISSION:

Letter of Nomination deadline:

Midnight on March 20, 2024 to Debbie Kerr at the Portland-Metro Student Services: Office 138 or email to portland@oit.edu.

Indicate the student's name and for which student award you are nominating the person. Clearly state how the student meets the student award criteria and why you are nominating the person for this award. Nomination is only considered for that specific award and not for others; however, you may nominate a student for more than one award with a separate nomination letter. Include a paragraph or sentence explaining how you know the person you are writing about and the nature of your relationship with them. Also include an evaluation of the student's skills and accomplishments.

Recommendation Letter(s) & Student Biography deadline:

Midnight on April 17, 2024 to Debbie Kerr at the Portland-Metro Student Services: Office 138 or email to portland@oit.edu.

It is highly encouraged by the Student Awards Commission that the student seeks at least one recommendation letter (no more than 5) from a student, staff, faculty, friend, or community member. The letter should express their support for the student award nomination with a few points from the above award criteria.
