Curriculum

18 credits are required to complete the ALPs minor. The credits can be earned by taking any courses with the following prefixes:

ART, HUM, LIT, MUS, or PHIL.

At least 12 of these credits must be earned from courses that are upper division (i.e. 300 level or higher).
