NOTES:

- Total degree program = 120 semester hours (SH) of which no more than 60 semester hours are required to be taken at Oregon Tech. Since Oregon Tech uses quarter hours (QH) instead of SH, a conversion must be applied for transfer credits as well as degree requirements: 1 SH = 1.5 QH. This is why the program shows 185 total credit hours with 92 applied from CCAF degree and 91 credits earned at Oregon Tech.
- This is a sample degree plan. Actual CCAF transfer credit may differ slightly depending on which General Education and Elective courses were taken to earn the CCAF Associate of Applied Science degree. Any adjustment to the course requirements will honor the 60 SH (90 QH) credit guarantee of the AU-ABC program.
- Recommended CCAF Gen Ed courses to maximize transfer credit and maximize opportunity for success in program: Social Science requirement - Micro- or Macro-Economics, Communication requirement - choose one Writing and one Speech course, and Math requirement - choose a Lab Science or College Algebra.
- Additional transfer credit may be awarded for courses taken in addition to the CCAF degree program (courses from regionally-accredited colleges or universities, CLEP, etc.) in accordance with Oregon Tech transfer credit policy and department approval.
