

STEP 1: Navigate to oit.edu/apply.

STEP 2: Click the **Apply Now** button for a Bachelor's Degree.

STEP 3: In the "Transfer" dropdown, select the **Apply as a Transfer Student** button.

STEP 4: Under the "Returning users" section, click on the **Log In** link and log in with your Oregon Tech email address.

*(If you have not logged in before, click on the **Create an account** link under the "First-time users" section)*

STEP 5: Once logged in, click the **Start New Application** link.

STEP 6: In the window that pops up, for the application type, select **Oregon Tech Application for Admission** and **Dual Enrollment** in the two drop downs. Then click **Create Application**.

STEP 7: Continue filling out the application, and when you get to the Academic Plans page, be sure to select the **Yes** box, indicating that you plan to also attend one of Oregon Tech's partner community colleges. Then click **Continue**.

STEP 8: Finish filling out the new application and submit. A link for the final Dual Enrollment Application will be emailed to you. Fill out the entire application and submit it.
