



## STUDENT AWARDS

### PRESIDENT'S SENIOR CUP

The **President's Senior Cup** is awarded to one undergraduate Outstanding Scholar from the college of Engineering, Technology, and Management and one undergraduate Outstanding Scholar from the college of Health, Arts, and Sciences who has demonstrated superior academic excellence as evidenced by very high cumulative grade point averages and other scholarly activities such as impressive senior projects, published work or acceptance into graduate school, and other criteria such as dependability, willingness to help others, involvement in activities and organizations.

The Oregon Tech President will select the President's Senior Cup recipients, one from each college, after reviewing those outstanding scholars nominated by the academic department with a letter of nomination.

#### ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

1. The student must be completing their final term for a bachelor's degree during the current academic year including summer session (Fall 2025, Winter 2026, Spring 2026 or Summer 2026).
2. The student's personal integrity should be unquestionable.
3. The student must have 75 Oregon Tech credits and an Oregon Tech GPA of at least 3.50 (no rounding up).
4. The student must be appointed by their department chair or program director as the Outstanding Scholar.
5. A letter of nomination from the department for President's Senior Cup must be submitted to the Student Affairs Office.
6. Student will submit a **Student Biography** before midnight on April 26, 2026, form located at: [\*\*Student Biography\*\*](#)

The **President's Senior Cup** is an engraved permanent trophy housed on the Klamath Falls campus in the Student Affairs Office in the College Union. The recipient is given an engraved cup and certificate to keep.

#### SUBMISSION:

Letter of Nomination deadline:

**Midnight on April 10, 2026 to Student Affairs: CU 217 (Klamath Falls) or [student.affairs@oit.edu](mailto:student.affairs@oit.edu)**

Indicate the student's name. Clearly state how the student meets the President's Senior Cup criteria and why you are nominating the person for this award. Include a paragraph or sentence explaining how you know the student you are writing about and the nature of your relationship with them. Also include an evaluation of the student's skills and accomplishments.

Recommendation Letter(s) & Student Biography deadline:

**Midnight on April 26, 2026 to Student Affairs: CU 217 (Klamath Falls) or [student.affairs@oit.edu](mailto:student.affairs@oit.edu)**

It is highly encouraged by the Student Awards Commission that the student seeks at least one recommendation letter (no more than 5) from a student, staff, faculty, friend or community member. The letter should express their support for the award nomination with a few points from the award criteria.
