VAC would like Oregon Tech to look into military course transfer credits to apply toward specific courses, much like the University of Denver. Right now all military courses are brought in as lower-division transfer credits. VAC would also like to see courses for military experience such as deployment and leadership/management training.

Suggestions made by Wendy Ivie and Marla Edge included Credit for Prior Learning where the veteran can create a portfolio to submit for multiple course credit, Courses Substitutions where the veteran will submit a form to advisor and department chair for approval of course by course, and/or Credit by Exam where the veteran will take an exam to prove knowledge of the subject and receive course credit. Also, Wendy will look over the example websites to research other university models.
