

Community Borrower Application

Klamath Basin residents are welcome to borrow circulating materials from the OIT Library. Privileges are granted at a cost of \$20.00 for one year. Approved applicants may borrow up to 10 items. Each family member must have his/her own Library account. Photo identification is required to check out material (e.g., ODL or Oregon ID). Requests for material NOT owned by OIT must go through the local public library. Applicants must be 18 years of age or older. Applicants younger than 18 years of age may be eligible for High-School borrowing privileges (see High School borrower's application).

To register, you are required to:

- Be an Oregon resident.
- Provide a driver's license or other photo identification AND proof of local residency.
- Provide your date of birth.
- Provide a social security number to Oregon Tech cashier's office.
- Provide proof of current mailing address, such as a utility bill.

Standard fines and replacement costs for late and lost books will charged. Photocopying is ten cents per page. Computer print outs require the purchase of a printing card at the OIT cashier's office in Snell Hall, room 117. Charges are 8 cents per side for black & white and 35 cents for color.
