



MEDICAL IMAGING TECHNOLOGY APPLICATION CHECKLIST 2020

TRANSFER STUDENTS

You must be a fully admitted Oregon Tech student, or be non-admit status with admission fall 2020, to apply to a medical imaging program.

All Pre-medical imaging prerequisite courses must be completed successfully, or in-progress to complete by the end of spring term 2020, in order to be eligible to apply.

From your non-official transcripts, you must populate the grade verification section: BIO 200, BIO 231, 232, 233, CHE 101, CHE 104, MATH 112, MIT 103, MATH 111, PSY 201, 202, or 203, SPE 111, WRI 121, WRI 122, Social Science & Humanities Electives

ALL PRE-REQUISITE COURSES MUST BE COMPLETED SUCCESSFULLY BY THE END OF SPRING TERM!

Below is a code key for entries for the grade verification section:

- A** - Enter an **A** for an A, A+, or A- grade
- B** - Enter a **B** for a B, B+, or B- grade
- C** - Enter a **C** for a C, C+, or C- grade
- D** - Enter a **D** for a D, D+, or D- grade
- F** - Enter **F** for a Failing grade
- T** - Tested out of MATH 111 and/or MATH 112 (example: Placement into MATH 251)
- IP** - Enter **IP** for courses that are in progress spring term
- R** - Enter **R** for courses being retaken **spring term**
- PB** - Make this entry for general education coursework that is satisfied through a previous BS, BA, or Master's degree (these courses include: WRI 121, WRI 122, SPE 111, MATH 111, PSY 201, Social Science & Humanities elective.)
- PP** - Indicates a 'Pass' for courses resulting in P/F (pass/fail)
- PF** - Indicates a 'Fail' for courses resulting in P/F (pass/fail)
