Curriculum

Our program, founded in 1977, offers students a diversified education experience designed to develop strong field provider skills, as well as EMS management and leadership training. Students with the discipline and drive to successfully complete our programs, earn eligibility for both state and national licensing exams.

Degree Options

Beyond the EMT certification, the EMS department offers two degree options:

- AAS degree in Paramedicine Students successfully completing the paramedic program earn an Associate of Applied Science Degree. Upon completion, graduates are eligible to take the National Registry examination. Completion of the examination process qualifies graduates for Oregon licensure and national certification.
- BS in EMS Management While your first two years are spent preparing for and then completing the paramedic program, your next two years are spent in studying general management practices, EMS specific management practices as well as advanced technical pre-hospital training in Critical Care Medicine.

Transferability

The program offers the complete general education and technical education requirements for both the 2-year Paramedic AAS degree and the 4-year BS in EMS Management degree at the Wilsonville Campus. We also offer excellent transferability to students who have completed some or all of their course work at an accredited college or university.

Program Accreditation
